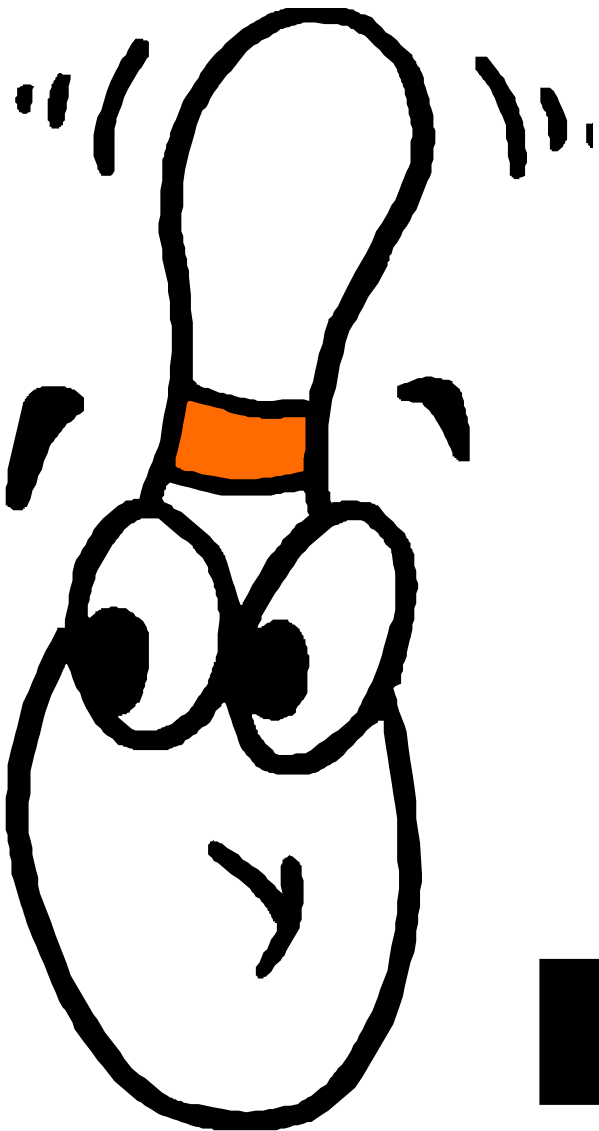

# Tournament Rules

Entries will be accepted until 1 hour prior to the start of *the first shift of the tournament* ( Dec 3<sup>rd</sup> ), subject to availability. Reserved entries are encouraged, as small squads may be cancelled.

1. Each member with a current Muncie USBC sanction card and in good standing may participate as many times as he/she wishes. Officers and Directors of the Muncie USBC are eligible to enter. No more than two players on a team may bowl together more than once.
2. Entrants may bowl doubles more than once; however they may not bowl with the same partner twice.
3. Each team will consist of two men and two women. Each doubles pair will consist of one man and one woman.
4. ***\*\*Any bowler not available and ready to bowl when it is their turn to bowl, without prior approval of a tournament official, shall receive zero for that frame, and scoring moved to the next bowler.***
5. Tournament averages will be defined as follows:
  - a. **Rule 319(a)(2) [ten-pin rule] will apply to this tournament as of the start of the tournament.**
  - b. Entrants shall use their highest Muncie USBC sanctioned league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2010-2011 season, established in leagues bowling their entire schedule in establishments certified through Muncie USBC Association. A bowler not having an official league average for the preceding season shall use his/her highest Muncie USBC sanctioned league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2009-10 season. A bowler not having an official league average for 2009-10 shall use his/her highest current Muncie USBC league sanctioned average with a minimum of 12 games as of the start of the tournament. Bowlers who do not qualify under the preceding provisions shall bowl scratch.
  - c. Bowlers having only a Sports League average are responsible to report their adjusted average per Rule 202(a) in the USBC Rule Book.
  - d. Bowlers are responsible for verifying his/her average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. Bowlers have until the end of the first game of a series to make corrections.
6. Handicap will be 100% of 480 in doubles and 100% of 960 in the team event.
7. Prize fee returned 100%.
8. Prize ratio: 1 : 6.
9. All entrants will be subject to re-rating per rule 319(e) [tournament averages].
10. All bowlers check-in time will be 30 minutes prior to the squad starting time. If all bowlers are checked-in early, the squad may be started early.
11. Any team or player arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl, but shall receive zeros for the frames missed. The score will count from whatever frame they start in.
12. Any protest affecting eligibility or playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Secretary within 72 hours. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Secretary within 72 hours.
13. Substitutes shall take the place in the lineup of the original entrant.
14. Returned checks will have a \$30.00 charge added.
15. Team captains will be responsible for writing down scores.
